Re: Hepatitis C virus (HCV) genotyping transition to send-out testing

Effective September 26, 2024 HCV genotyping will no longer be performed in-house due to discontinuation of the assay by the manufacturer. HCV genotyping will transition to an equivalent test offering at ARUP Laboratories. The HCV genotyping order will include the required HCV quantitative viral load, which will be performed at the reference laboratory on the same sample. There is no need to order a separate HCV quantitative viral load.
