Urine

Refrigerate if unable to deliver to lab immediately

Collect first catch urine in sterile cup

Transfer up to the dotted line of the YELLOW urine collection device (pictured).

Stability in GeneXpert Collection Device: 3 days room temperature (for CT/NG) 14 days room temperature (For Trich)


Swabs

(Trich = Vaginal ONLY; CT/NG = Vag, Rectal, Throat)

PINK capped (not red) GeneXpert Swab Collection Device **DISCARD LARGE SWAB!**

Use small swab for collection


Stability: 60 days room temperature



Vaginal Self-Swab Collection Instructions


<u>Step 1:</u>

Open kit that contains the pink-capped tube, small swab and large swab. DISCARD the larger swab.



<u>Step 2:</u>

Carefully insert the tip of the small swab about 2 inches into the opening of your vagina and gently rotate the swab for 10-30 seconds. Take the swab out of your vagina



<u>Step 3:</u>

Unscrew the pink cap from the transport tube. Immediately place the collection swab into the transport tube. Break the swab shaft at the score mark.



<u>Step 4:</u>

Put cap back tightly on the test tube to prevent leaking. Try not to splash liquid out of the tube.




<u>Step 5:</u>

Discard wrapper and unused swab. Wash your hands. Return the tube to the health worker.

Rectal Self-Swab Collection Instructions


<u>Step 1:</u>

Open kit that contains the pink-capped tube, small swab and large swab. DISCARD the larger swab.



<u>Step 2:</u>

Carefully insert the tip of the small swab approximately 1 in beyond the anus. Gently rotate the swab for 5-10 seconds.



<u>Step 3:</u>

Unscrew the pink cap from the transport tube. Immediately place the collection swab into the transport tube. Break the swab shaft at the score mark.



<u>Step 4:</u>

Put cap back tightly on the test tube to prevent leaking. Try not to splash liquid out of the tube.




<u>Step 5:</u>

Discard wrapper and unused swab. Wash your hands. Return the tube to the health worker.

Pharyngeal Swab Collection Instructions


<u>Step 1:</u>

Open kit that contains the pink-capped tube, small swab and large swab. DISCARD the larger swab.



<u>Step 2:</u>

Instruct patient to open mouth widely and position tongue toward bottom of the mouth. Be sure to make good contact with 5 key areas of the throat (see below).



<u>Step 3:</u>

Unscrew the pink cap from the transport tube. Immediately place the collection swab into the transport tube. Break the swab shaft at the score mark.



<u>Step 4:</u>

Put cap back tightly on the test tube to prevent leaking. Try not to splash liquid out of the tube.



<u>Step 5:</u>

Discard wrapper and unused swab. Wash your hands. Return the tube to the health worker.
